		<ul> <li>What else does this study have to say? (Have some key results simply been cherry-picked?)</li> </ul>
		Who else can you talk to about this
Motivation	Who did the research and	Who funded the research?
	why?	Who conducted the research?
		Is there a vested interest?
		<ul> <li>Are the researchers reporting their findings or attempting to influence an audience?</li> </ul>
Quality	How do the researchers know the things they claim?	How many people did they ask?
		<ul> <li>How did they select these people?</li> </ul>
		How did they ask them?
		What did they ask them?
Always be wary if you cannot get access to the original research questionnaire, data coding schedule, and the raw data; and be wary of research that concludes with the call for more research.		When did they ask them?
		<ul> <li>What analytical techniques were used?</li> </ul>
		<ul> <li>How did they interpret the results?</li> </ul>
		Have the data been weighted?
		<ul> <li>Are the researchers clear about the limitations of the re- search?</li> </ul>

		<ul> <li>How have the researchers avoided common biases such as selection bias; confirmation bias; publication bias; the implicit referent; and the ecological fallacy?</li> </ul>
